GENERAL RULES

1. Applicants should submit age proof certificate. **01-07-2020** is the basis for age consideration.
2. Application forms (Vocal / Instrument / Quiz) will be issued from **7th April 2020 Tuesday**, and can be obtained only through email. For obtaining vide email, kindly send a request to **rrsabha@gmail.com** by furnishing the Name of the Candidate, Date of Birth & Category (Vocal / Instrument / Quiz).
3. Application form duly completed in all respects (along with age proof certificate for Sub-Juniors & Juniors) should reach the Sabha office on or before **8.00 p.m. on 16th Saturday May 2020**. For Quiz program (both Junior & Senior) spot registration is available & the fee for spot registration is Rs.100/-
4. Application submitted after **16th May** and on or before **28th May (Thursday) 8.00 p.m** (Last Date with late fee) will be charged an additional fee of Rs.25/- per Competition/Composer. The application received at the Sabha after 16th May, even if the DD is taken on or before **16th May** should pay the stipulated additional fees..
5. Demand Drafts are to be drawn in favour of "**Hon. Secretary, Rasika Ranjana Sabha (Regd.), Trichy - 2**", for entrance fees and to be forwarded along with the filled in applications. **Please note that postal Orders, Money orders & Cheques will not be accepted.**
6. No change in the songs will be entertained after the submission of application. If an applicant does not fill up the details of required number of compositions for any composer, the applicant will be debarred from participating in the particular Comeptition.
7. Competition Schedule for all Categories:

8. The contestants should be present in the Sabha atleast thirty minutes before the commencement of the competition.
9. The contestants have to Sing / Play in the order in which they are listed.
10. The Competition may **extend upto 8.00 p.m. on all days.**
11. The exact date and time of competitions will be notified in the notice board provided at the Sabha office and in RR Sabha website (www.rrsabha.in) 3days before the commencement of the respective Competition.
12. The decision of the Judges for the respective competitions, shall be final.
13. Method of awarding prizes

I Prize	}	: One who obtains not less than 60% and stands first among the competitors.
II Prize		: One who obtains not less than 50% and stands next to I Prize winner.
III Prize		: One who obtains not less than 40% and stands next to II Prize winner.

The contestants shall not be eligible for any prize inspite of their ranks unless they secure minimum percentage of marks as set out above.
14. Prize Distribution: A celebrated dignitary will award Prizes and Title to the winners at a special function that will be held during August '2020.
15. Contestants for instrumental competitions have to make their own arrangements for prompting thalams.
16. In Sub-Junior category (Vocal) and in all categories (Instrumental) those who had obtained the first prize in the earlier years are not eligible for contesting again in the same category.
17. The Sabha will provide lodging facilities for candidates participating from other states (except Pondichery), on their dates of competition. Transportation and boarding are to be borne by the candidates. For receiving prizes, to & fro Second class conveyance charges, by train, will be reimbursed for candidates from other states (except Pondichery) securing a minimum of Three (3) prizes in Vocal (Junior / Senior Category) and also for candidates Securing first prize in Sub-Junior (Vocal) or in Insturment Category.

2. Competitors who are not competing for "**Sangeetha Sri**" title are not eligible to compete in **Section 'C'**
3. Applicants are also required to render Raga Alapana (Max. 3 minutes) with crisp Niraval & Swara in Section - A, under Sl.No. 1,4 & 8.
- 4) **Violin** : A special prize in memory of **Sripriya Madhav** will be awarded to the first prize winner in Senior violin (apart from the first prize)
5. **SANGEETHA SRI.**
 - a) Competitors who aspire for the coveted "**Sangeetha Sri**" should participate in all the items of Section A & B, in any two items in section C and in the Quiz programme. Candidates should obtain not less than 60 % marks in each group (A, B and C only). They are not permitted to participate in Sl. No. 28 to 36 of Section D.
 - b) The candidates should come prepared with a list of 3 classical compositions of the musical trinity other than those submitted by the applicant in Section-A and 2 from post trinity composers other than those submitted by the applicant in section-B in different ragas (2 Melakarta & 3 Janya ragas out of which atleast 1 prathi madhyamam) and thalas (Tisra Tripuda, Chaturra Tripuda, Kanda Chapu, Misra Jampai & Misra Chapu). Based on the choice of the Judges, the contestants will render Raga Alapana in detail, in the composition and finally apt passage therein for rendering elaborate Niraval & Kalpana Swara. The candidate should also be prepared to respond to the queries posed by the judges, which will be based on their presentation. The maximum time permitted for rendering Ragam, Thanam, Pallavi (Item 21) under Section 'B' is 30 minutes and minimum 25 minutes.
 - c) The title will be conferred on the basis of the marks obtained in Sec. 'A', Sec.' B', Sec 'C', Quiz, the final (5b) and on the considered opinion of the judges.
